




Congressman Michaud's Washington Internship Program



Congressman Michaud's Washington office sponsors internship programs throughout the year. Programs in Washington are typically unpaid; however, some interns will be granted a need-based stipend to cover the costs of housing and transportation. Interns are accepted any time of the year although it is best if a student can work for a full semester (fall or spring) or summer. A three-month period of time allows the student to truly experience life in a Congressional office. Internships are available on a full-time or part-time basis. While the office maintains a rolling deadline, please be advised that summer months fill particularly quickly and applicants should apply at their earliest convenience. Be aware that Congressman Michaud's office is not responsible for providing or locating intern housing.

All interns must submit a completed application package including:

- A completed application form
- Two letters of reference
- A 1-2 page writing sample

Acceptance to the program will be based on:

- Demonstrated interest in the legislative process and politics
- Writing ability
- Availability

Preference will be given to applicants who:

- Are a current or former resident of Maine or have a parent who is a Maine resident
- Have completed one full year of college (post high school graduation)
- Are at least 18 years of age
